The non-governmental organization Women4Cyber Montenegro was established as the national chapter of the European Foundation Women4Cyber. Established in 2019 by the European Cybersecurity Organization (ECSO) and the European Commission, Women4Cyber Foundation has been at the forefront of advocating for greater gender equality and representation in the cybersecurity industry.

The mission of Women4Cyber Montenegro mirrors that of its European counterpart. Its primary objectives are:
1. Identifying and Connecting: Women4Cyber Montenegro seeks to identify and link individuals within the cybersecurity community, fostering invaluable contacts, visibility, and networking opportunities.

2. **Development and Growth**: The organization is committed to developing and growing the cybersecurity community by promoting awareness, education, training, and support within the job market.

3. Shaping Policy and Actions: Women4Cyber Montenegro actively works to shape local, national, and EU policies and actions in collaboration with the wider Women4Cyber network.
4. Community Building: Together with the Women4Cyber network, the Montenegrin chapter aims to work collectively to structure and grow the initiative, ensuring long-term sustainability and impact.



Launching event

Women4Cyber Montenegro officially launched at the Her CyberTracks Europe Forum, a remarkable initiative organized by the International Telecommunication Union (ITU) and German Agency for International Cooperation (GIZ) in collaboration with the Western Balkan Cyber Capacity Centre, hosted by the University of Montenegro.

Our representatives, Andreja Mihailović, Neli Rašović, Denisa Kurtagić, and Isidora Stanković, familiarized the participants with the vision, mission, and goals of W4C Montenegro.







During the presentation, it was underscored the critical importance of elevating cyber security awareness on a national scale. This effort stands as a fundamental prerequisite for fostering an environment conducive to ongoing economic growth and digital transformation. A significant spotlight was placed on the cyber security labor market, highlighting a substantial gap in both representation and income, particularly when comparing men and women in the field.





As a bonus, W4C representatives organized an interactive simulation during the Forum to acquaint participants with the complexities of the cyber crisis. This engaging exercise highlighted the major challenges and presented effective approaches for timely and coordinated cyber crisis resolution.

Cyber Security in the Service of Business Improvement: Optimizing Risks for Competitive Advantage

We are thrilled to have applauded for the conference titled 'Cyber Security in the Service of Business Improvement: Optimizing Risks for Competitive Advantage', which was organized by the Science and Technology Park at the University of Montenegro and Sky Express Montenegro, in collaboration with ICT Cortex and WB3C. The panel moderated by Andreja Mihailović, the president of Women4Cyber Montenegro, focused on how to improve cyber security education through EdTech. Inspiring speakers, such as prof. Nikola Žarić, Andrej Nikitin, Predrag Puharić, Marko Lakić and Iva Lazić, shared their insights and experiences on cyber security.

The new interdisciplinary master program "Information Security" offered by the University of Montenegro, which aims to train experts who can tackle complex challenges in this field, was also presented.

We hope that this conference will inspire the future of cyber security education and contribute to the creation of a safer business and educational environment.

















Gathering at the W4C Foundation event in Brussels

We are excited to announce that we had a successful gathering at the Women4Cyber Foundation event in Brussels last week. Our VP Denisa Kurtagić met with other colleagues from the Foundation, as well as from the Italian and Greek Chapters, and shared our progress and challenges in cybersecurity.

During the event, we discussed several topics, including the launch of W4C Montenegro Chapter and our participation in the ITU mentorship project (Her CyberTrack), where Denisa is a mentor for aspiring women in cyber. We also talked about modalities of collaboration and mutual benefit from expertise exchange, with the support of the W4C Foundation in our initiatives. Additionally, we discussed strategies for expanding our membership and partnerships, along with the identification of best practices for achieving these objectives. We also talked about the preparations for the upcoming W4C annual Conference "Hacking Gender Barriers", to be held in Madrid on 14-15 November 2023.

Finally, we discussed approaches to enhance visibility and attain recognition at the EU level, as well as methods to engage with various EU projects and programs.
